The Beatification of Fr Richard Henkes SAC

takes place in Limburg today.

Richard Henkes was born in Germany in 1900.

He wanted to become a priest and missionary and joined the Pallottine junior seminary in Vallendar-Schonstadt in 1912. His studies were interrupted when he was called up for military service. In 1919 he entered the Pallottine Novitiate in Limburg and he was ordained in 1925 and worked as a teacher in Pallottine schools. He also preached during pilgrimages and retreats.

As he exalted the Christian image of man in the face of National Socialist racist policies, he came into conflict with the Nazi authorities. In 1941 he was appointed Parish Priest in a village in Hultschin. Here he mediated between the German and the Czech population. On 8th April 1943 he openly took a stand against the deportation of disabled people from the hospital. He was arrested and sent first to the prison at Ratibor and then to the concentration cap at Dachau. While there he learned Czech and took care of Czech prisoners. During the typhus epidemic of 1944-45, he took care of the sick people and volunteered to be locked in the quarantine block with them. He was infected with typhus and died on 22nd February 1945.
