First Holy Communion course 2024: important information.

If your child is turning 8 in this academic year, is in Year 3, has been Baptised and at least 1 parent is a Baptised Catholic, they are eligible to take part in the First Holy Communion programme this year.

Application forms will be available to collect on Saturday 6th January, after the 6pm Mass and on Sunday 7th January, after the 10am Mass.

Completed forms will need to be handed in the following weekend, after the weekend Masses (Saturday 13th 6pm and Sunday 14th 10am).

Once the applications have been reviewed and if your child meets the application criteria, you will be invited to attend a parent meeting to discuss the course programme. The initial parent

Coming in January

It's almost two years since we held meetings and conversations as part of the preparation for the Synod 2021-2024 which Pope Francis called in order to give voice to as many people as possible. Out of respect for that process and the effort put in by many people, we will in January distribute printed copies of the Synthesis Report of the First Session which took place in October 2023. The second session will take place in October 2024. On January 2nd Bishop Richard will publish the third edition of the Pastoral Plan - The Word Who Is Life – for our diocese.

Both documents call all of us to a period of reflection, participation, and prayer, especially Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Pope Francis has stressed that there is no Synodal Path without Adoration
